1. Introduction & core loop

Examevo turns handwritten exam practice into improvement intelligence — per-question marks, lost-mark reasons, predicted grades, and patterns that compound across every paper.

The core loop (every role connects here)

Practise on paper → sit timed exam or upload photos → AI marks against the board mark scheme (~2 min) → read results → fix weak topics → repeat.

Primary student path today: subject hub → timed **exam session** → photograph pages → marking. Teachers assign the same exam session from school. Legacy photo upload remains at `/submit`.

3. Student — onboarding & home dashboard

3.1 First-time onboarding

- 1 After registering, you are guided through **year group**, **exam board** (AQA, Edexcel, OCR, WJEC/Eduqas, CCEA), and **subjects**.
- 2 On completion you may be redirected to your **first timed paper** in the library — sit it in-app for an immediate predicted grade.
- 3 If you skip subjects, you are sent to `/my-subjects` to enrol before using the app fully.

3.2 Home dashboard (`/home`)

Your command centre after onboarding. Key areas:

Area	What it shows	What to do
Hero / readiness	Greeting, exam countdown, average grade, usage meter	See where you stand at a glance
Today's priority	One suggested action (weak topic, exam proximity, practice)	Tap the CTA — usually Learn or Library
Teacher assignments	Pending school papers with due-date badges	Tap to start exam session; appears when you joined a class
Subjects carousel	Enrolled subjects with grades & paper counts	Open a subject hub
Recent activity	Latest submissions & marking status	Open completed papers for full results
Fix these first	Top weak topics from recent marking	Jump to Learn for teaching cards
Exam countdown	Days until each subject's exam date	Manage dates on <code>/exams</code>
Predictions & review	Exam topic predictions, spaced-repetition review	Expand drawer at bottom of home

Free plan

One full paper per month on one subject — all marking features included. Parent dashboard is free. Upgrade at `/upgrade`.

4. Student — subjects, library & exam session

4.1 My subjects (`/my-subjects`)

- View all enrolled GCSE/A-Level subjects with paper counts and latest grades.
- **Catalog badges:** Library live · Limited library · Coming soon — honest status per subject.
- Set **target grade** and **exam date** per subject (powers countdown & predictions).
- Add or remove subjects; board comes from your profile.

4.2 Subject hub (`/my-subjects/[id]`)

Everything for one subject in one place:

- **Past papers** — sit in-app (recommended) or view PDFs where published.
- **Your attempts** — previous submissions for this subject.
- **Coverage panel** — how many library papers exist and which years.
- **Start exam** on any published paper → opens exam session.

4.3 Library (`/library`)

Browse Examevo model papers across qualifications (GCSE, A-Level, IGCSE, etc.). Filter by subject and board. Use **View & print** for the question paper; write answers on separate paper, then sit via subject hub or exam session.

4.4 Exam session — primary way to sit a paper

`/my-subjects/[subjectId]/exam/[paperId]`

- 1 **Choose mode:** Handwritten (default) or typed answers where supported.
- 2 **Timed booklet:** Read questions on screen; timer runs like a real exam.
- 3 **Finish & submit:** For handwritten — photograph each page (up to 12 photos). For typed — answers submit directly.
- 4 **Marking:** Usually ~2 minutes. You can leave; results appear under Papers.
- 5 **School assignments:** URL includes `?assignment=` — after submit you return to `/classes`.

4.5 Submit upload (`/submit`) — alternative path

Use when you sat any past paper (not only Examevo library) or prefer standalone upload:

- 1 Select subject, board, year, paper type.
- 2 Upload clear photos (JPEG/PNG/WebP) or PDF — all pages, good lighting.
- 3 Confirm and submit. Same marking pipeline as exam session.

4.6 My classes (`/classes`)

- **Join a class:** Enter teacher's join code.
- **Assignments:** See title, class, due date (colour-coded: overdue / today / soon), status.
- **Start paper:** Tap assignment → exam session with assignment linked.
- After marking completes, teacher sees your grade on the class dashboard.

5. Student — results, improvement & intelligence

5.1 Papers list (/papers)

All submissions: marking in progress, complete, or failed. Tap any complete paper for full breakdown.

5.2 Results detail (/results/[id])

Section	What you get
Overall grade	Predicted grade, total marks, percentage
Per-question	Marks awarded, lost-mark reasons, method errors
Teaching cards	How to fix phrasing, structure, command words
Weak topics	Topics ranked by marks lost
Near misses	Questions where you almost had full marks
Flag marking	"Something wrong with this marking?" — sends to admin review queue

5.3 Learning DNA (/progress)

Recurring error patterns across all your papers — e.g. missing units, weak command words, diagram labels. Critical patterns surface on home.

5.4 Topics / Learn (/learn)

Teaching content for weak topics flagged in your marking. Open from results, home, or search by topic name.

5.5 Practice (/practice)

Short targeted questions on topics you are mastering. Tracks mastery stats (topics mastered, in progress, attempts).

5.6 Predictions (/predict)

Board-aware topic predictions based on historical patterns (Plus/Complete). Shows likely topics and priority revision areas per subject.

5.7 Syllabus (/syllabus)

Browse official topic lists for your board and subject — useful for checklist revision.

5.8 Achievements & career

- /achievements — streaks and milestones.
- /career — career paths matched to your grades and subjects (Complete features).

6. Student — exams, programme, classes & account

6.1 My exams (/exams)

Countdown per enrolled subject. Edit exam dates and target grades inline. Board-aware grade predictions shown per subject.

6.2 6-week programme (/programme)

Structured study plan (Complete plan): weekly tasks, papers to sit, progress unlocking next week. Completing a marked paper can auto-complete the active programme week.

Enrol at </programme/enroll> if not yet on a programme.

6.3 Settings & upgrade

Page	Purpose
/settings	Profile, exam board, year group, notifications, sign out
/upgrade	Compare Free / Plus / Complete and subscribe

7. Parent dashboard

Free with every student account — no separate parent subscription.

7.1 Setup

- 1 Register at `/register` → **Parent**.
- 2 On `/dashboard`, click **Add student**.
- 3 Enter the **email your child used** for their student account and confirm the link.
- 4 Repeat for multiple children.

Children must register as Students first. Parents cannot submit papers on a child's behalf.

7.3 How to support at home

- Encourage **one paper per week** per priority subject.
- Discuss **specific weak topics** from the dashboard, not vague “revise more”.
- Use weekly reports before parents' evening.
- Let the student sit and submit — you monitor outcomes.

8. School & teacher portal

Assign papers, track class completion, export cohort reports — without marking stacks on your desk.

8.1 Access

- 1 Register at `/register` → **Teacher**, or request a pilot at `/for-schools`.
- 2 Open `/school/dashboard`.
- 3 Follow the in-app **Setup guide** (`/school/dashboard/guide`) — 4 steps with live progress.

8.2 Setup guide (4 steps)

Step	Where	Action
1. Create class	<code>/school/dashboard/students</code>	Name class, link subject/year
2. Share join code	<code>/school/dashboard/classes/[id]</code>	Copy code → students enter at <code>/classes</code>
3. Assign paper	<code>/school/dashboard/assign</code>	Class + published library paper + optional due date
4. Review results	<code>/school/dashboard/reports</code>	Grades, weak topics, CSV export

8.4 Assignments & student flow

- 1 Teacher assigns from library → student sees task on `/classes` and home.
- 2 Student taps **Start paper** → timed exam session (not legacy upload).
- 3 Student photographs script → AI marks automatically.
- 4 Teacher sees completion & grade on class detail → **ClassAssignmentsPanel**.
- 5 Due-date badges: overdue (red), today (amber), due soon.

8.5 Reports & CSV export

On `/school/dashboard/reports`:

- Filter by class or view all cohorts.

- **Parents evening pack** — one CSV with student grades + cohort weak topics.
- **Grades CSV** — class, student, email, papers, grade, trend, top weak topics.
- **Topics CSV** — topic frequency and marks lost across scripts.
- **Student topics CSV** — per-student weak topic breakdown.

9. How all roles connect

Who	Action	Who else sees it
Teacher	Assigns Paper 1 Biology, due Friday	Student: /classes + home reminder; parent: activity feed
Student	Sits exam session & submits	All marks; teacher sees grade; parent dashboard updates
Student	Flags incorrect marking	Admin reviews in Operations queue
Teacher	Exports parents evening CSV	Same weak topics parents see on dashboard
Parent	Reads weekly report	Aligns with teacher cohort reports

Mock-season rhythm (recommended)

1. **Week 1:** Assign one paper per class; students submit by deadline.
2. **Week 2:** Review Reports + Interventions; re-teach top 2 class weak topics.
3. **Ongoing:** Students use Learn/Practice; parents check weekly report.
4. **Before exams:** Repeat — Learning DNA shows what is actually improving.

10. Admin portal (operations team)

Internal team only — content, users, marking quality, and platform health.

Marking feedback flags: When a student flags results, review at Operations → mark reviewed or dismissed.

Upload tips for best marking

- Flat surface, even lighting, all corners visible — one photo per page (up to 12).
- Handwritten scripts only for full exam papers; typed mode where offered in exam session.
- Match subject, board, and paper type to what you actually sat.

Privacy

- Parents see only **linked** students.
- Teachers see only students who **joined their class**.
- Scripts stored securely for marking and progress tracking.
